1. Preparatory Phase



- Do we need a Link NCA? Why? Where exactly?
- Which data is already available?
- Resources? Security? Stakeholders?
- Selection and training of the researcher (analyst)...



2. Identifying hypothetical pathway and risks factors + consensus

- ✓ Inadequate IYCF practices
- ✓ High Women workload
- ✓ Poor access to health center
- ✓ Poor utilization of Health Center
- ✓ Lack of sanitation
- ✓ Poor hygiene practices
- ✓ Poor access to safe water sources
- ✓ Poor incomes from agriculture
- ✓ Poor empowerment of women/ Social status.....



5. Programming: translate results into actions A



- Community consultation
- Multi actor technical workshop
- Sharing with national key Stakeholders (Local authorities, CBOs, NGOs, Government, UN, donors...)
- Development of a logical framework



Evolutions for 2018



- Make the tool more flexible
- Go beyond the barrier of homogeneity
- A clearly defined operational objective at the start of the study
- Influence programming through first and final steps
- A first step in the project cycle management
